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Santa Clara University Leavey Center Lowney Associates is providing environmental and geotechnical services during design and construction of the \$11.75 million remodel of Santa Clara University's Leavey Center, formerly known as Toso Pavilion. Phase 1 work included installation of deep, concrete caisson foundations to support the new roof and installation of a glass window wall around the arena. Phases 2 to 4 will include a new entryway and plaza, interior improvements such as locker rooms and exercise facilities, 25,000 square feet of additional office space, 1,200 new spectator seats, and a new outdoor aquatic center. The arena will hold 5,000 spectators upon its 2002 completion. Devcon Construction is the general contractor. The architect is Ellerbe Becket.

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
